The treaty exemption is available only for compensation paid during a period of five taxable years beginning with the taxable year that includes my arrival date, and for such additional period of time as is nexessary to complete, as a full-time student, educational requirements as a candidate for a postgraduate or professional degree from a recognized educational institution.
